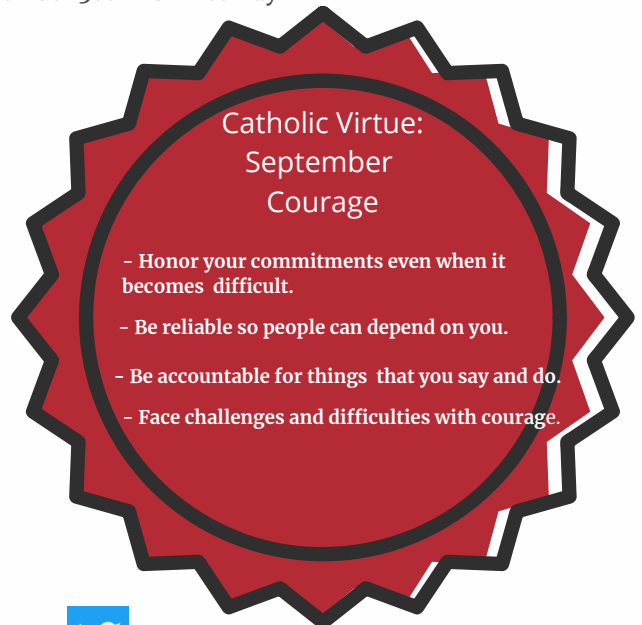
Looking forward to seeing many of you at our Curriculum Night next week!
