School Day Cashless System: The School Day Cashless System at Holy Name continues to be a great success with close to 50% of our families registered thus far. There is no fee to sign up for the School Day App. When using the system, there is a 3% service charge applied to the cost of each transaction. To register, follow the instructions found in the email sent on <u>Monday May 1st</u>. This email contains specific instructions on how to register with an individualized Secure-Match<sup>™</sup> Key password.

The School Day Cashless System provides real-time, secure access to up-to-date information and the ability to:

- complete online payments for trips, hot lunch and other activities;
- avoid the risks associated with sending money to school with your child;
- approve permission forms instantly online;
- reduce the environmental impact of photocopying permission forms and announcements;
- register your child for extra-curricular events;
- update your mobile device with calendar events specific to your child.

Please consider the following helpful hints if you are having difficulty locating the email containing the instructions and *match key password*:

- The email you will receive will *not* be from Holy Name CES. The attached picture is an example of what the email will look like.
- Check your 'Junk Mail/Folder.'
- Search "secure match key" when in your email.
- If necessary, call the school. We are able to pull up each 'Match Key Password' with ease and help out!

We have already begun using this efficient and convenient tool for the upcoming Grade 2 Rosary Making and Junior Dance workshops. We will be continuing to use the School Day Cashless System for the remainder of the year which will include the upcoming 2022/2023 School Yearbook purchase.
