School Dress Code: A reminder that for the rest of the week/year (except for designated days) students are to be in the proper school dress code. School Day Cashless System: The School Day Cashless System at Holy Name has begun with a successful start with close to 50% of our families registered thus far. There is no fee to sign up for the School Day App. When using the system, there is a 3% service charge applied to the cost of each transaction. To register, follow the instructions found in the email sent on <u>Monday May 1st</u>. This email contains specific instructions on how to register with an individualized **Secure-Match<sup>™</sup> Key password**.

The School Day Cashless System provides real-time, secure access to up-to-date information and the ability to:

- complete online payments for trips, hot lunch and other activities;
- avoid the risks associated with sending money to school with your child;
- approve permission forms instantly online;
- reduce the environmental impact of photocopying permission forms and announcements;
- register your child for extra-curricular events;
- update your mobile device with calendar events specific to your child.

We have already begun using this efficient and convenient tool for the upcoming Grade 2 Rosary Making workshop. Parents have been able to provide consent and payment through the School Day Cashless System which can be accessed from any web browser. We will be continuing to use the School Day Cashless System for the remainder of the year. Some upcoming school events that will be made available through the School Day System include the Junior Division Dance Workshops, Scientist in the School (Kindergarten classes) and the 2022/2023 School Yearbook purchase.

We look forward to reaching our goal of 100% of our families participating in using this tool. Please contact the school if you have any questions or need assistance.
