**Footwear**: Students are required to wear proper footwear throughout the school day. Flip flops and crocs not permitted



**Bus Loop:** Please do not enter the bus loop during morning entry (8:45 am - 9:00 am) and afternoon dismissal (3:30 pm - 4:00 pm) procedures.

**Anaphylactic Allergies and Medical Concerns:** If your child has specific anaphylactic and/or medical concerns, please notify the office so that all information and forms are kept up to date. Please contact the office if you have questions.

**School Day Cashless System:** The School Day Cashless System at Holy Name is continuing this year. We are currently at a success rate of 82% of our families registered thus far. There is no fee to sign up for the School Day App. When using the system, there is a 3% service charge applied to the cost of each transaction. The School Day Cashless System provides real-time, secure access to up-to-date information and the ability to:

- complete online payments for trips, hot lunch and other activities;
- avoid the risks associated with sending money to school with your child;
- approve permission forms instantly online;
- reduce the environmental impact of photocopying permission forms and announcements;
- register your child for extra-curricular events;
- update your mobile device with calendar events specific to your child.

New families to Holy Name will have received an email this past week with instructions and the Secure Match Key for your child(ren) to register onto School Day. Please contact the school if you require assistance.

We have already begun using this efficient and convenient tool this year with the 2023/2024 School Agenda ready for purchase for \$7.00. In addition the Hot Lunch Program will also be made available for families to purchase through the School Day program. Further information will follow about the Hot Lunch Program.
