Hello Holy Name Families,

We have had a great start to the school year and would like to share updates with you. Please review this week's Weekly Update.

Bussing: We thank you for your patience as bus drivers adjust to new routes, pick-up and drop-off times. A reminder to all parents of students who ride the bus to and from school that they are to ONLY ride on their designated bus and not switch buses. In the case of extenuating circumstances, please contact the school.

Parking Lot: Thank you to all parents for helping to ensure the safety of our students during pick-up and drop-off. The flow of traffic in our Kiss and Ride loop is improving. A reminder, please do not leave your vehicle unattended or parked in the Fire Routes and/or in the Kiss and Ride.
