With the start of Fall upon us, we welcome the crisp air and colorful leaves and are excited to kick off a busy week filled with engaging events and activities for our students and Holy Name community! Here's a look at what is happening this week at Holy Name.

Terry Fox Run: Students and staff will participate in the annual Terry Fox School Walk on **Monday, September 23rd**. Everyone is invited to wear red and/or white and all students will receive a Terry Fox walk sticker where they can print the name of the person they are walking for. Rowan's Law Day: The last Wednesday of each September is Rowan's Law Day in honour of Rowan Stringer who tragically passed away as a result of multiple head injuries she sustained while playing rugby. On Wednesday, September 25, 2024, Holy Name as well as schools across Ontario will recognize the importance of this law which brings increased awareness about concussions. Students and staff are invited to wear purple on this day to recognize and honour the importance of this law.

Curriculum Night/Corn Roast: Our Corn Roast will take place on Thursday, September 26, 2024 from 5:30 p.m. and continue until 8:00 p.m. Each student will receive a complimentary corn on the cob and water. Any additional corn is available to be purchased using School Day until Sunday, September 22nd.
