P.A.Day: A reminder to all families that **Monday**, **October 21st** is a P.A. Day and there is no school for students on this day. School staff will participate in School Improvement Planning and goal setting for student success for this school year. Staff will also complete a number of online safety training modules. These modules continue to support and monitor the health and safety of all our students and staff.

Civvies Day: As we approach the end of the month, HNE students are invited to participate in our monthly civvies day this **Friday**, **October 25th**. Students are invited to come to school in their favourite casual attire. A reminder that students are to wear appropriate attire for school.

International Walk to School Month: (IWALK) is an annual event that takes place in October to raise awareness about the benefits of walking and other types of active transportation to get to and from school. It is a great opportunity for students, families, and the school community to be part of a global event to celebrate the benefits of active transportation. Halloween Costumes: As we look forward to Halloween Day students are invited to wear costumes or Halloween colours on this day. If students choose to wear a costume please note the following reminders when choosing a costume to wear to school:

- All students are reminded that costume props, and/or replica weapons including, but not limited to, toy guns, knives, axes, swords, etc., may not be brought to school.
- Masks as part of a costume are not to be worn at school as they present a safety risk, and some masks may even be quite scary to the younger students.
- Costumes should be respectful of the diversity in our communities and therefore should not reflect symbols or objects representative of another person's culture and/or race that may trivialize, devalue, or appropriate any culture or race. Costumes that mock social identities through stereotyping are also unacceptable.
- Students are discouraged from wearing costumes that are not appropriate to the moral tone of our Catholic schools.

If students are unsure about their costume idea, they should speak with their classroom teacher and/or administration. We are looking forward to a fun and respectful Halloween for all.
