Inclement Weather Information: With December approaching and the weather changing, we are sharing information about inclement weather days set out by the YCDSB. Please make note of the following should school transportation be canceled due to inclement weather and/or poor road conditions:

- Schools will remain open
- Parents are asked to use the <u>Safe Arrival System</u> to report student absence
- Hot Lunch programs will be canceled.
- We ask that you exercise discretion in deciding whether to send your child to school
- When school transportation is canceled in the morning, it will not operate in the afternoon.
- Tests, quizzes, excursions, charter trips, school programs, co-curricular activities, parent meetings, etc. will be rescheduled.
- Permits will be canceled by noon on the inclement weather day.
- Before and After School Programs will make every effort to remain open in inclement weather. However, the decision to open or to close early is up to the discretion of the Child Care Operator.
