School Day Events Added: The following items have been added to School Day. Please log on to order and make online payments.

- FDK/Primary Trip: The FDK and Primary Classes will be attending an interactive and engaging performance of PigMania on Tuesday, March 25th at the Markham Theater. The cost of this trip is \$35.00 and payment and consent forms can be completed online through School Day on or before Tuesday, March 18, 2025.
- Hot Lunch: Phase 3 of our Hot Lunch program begins on April 1st and runs until June 26, 2025. Ordering via School Day is open and orders can be placed up until Friday, March 21, 2025. Hard copies of the ordering forms are available in the office if needed.
