We encourage families to review the important dates for January and to check our website regularly for updates, announcements, and upcoming events.

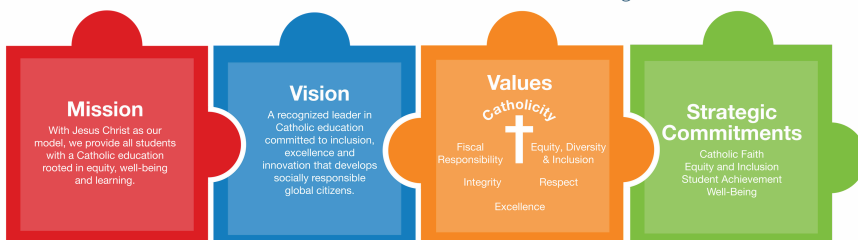
Thank you for your continued support and partnership. Wishing you a happy, healthy, and fulfilling January ahead.
